

Rosslyn Castle

A 32 bar jig for 3 couples.

- 1 - 2 The first man and woman set;
- 3 - 4 change places giving right hands; and
- 5 - 6 join nearer hands with the second woman and man. All four set to partners; and
- 7 - 8 change places with them, giving right hands.

- 9 - 10 The second man and woman join nearer hands with the dancers on either side of them (who will actually be their comers); all six set; and
- 11 - 12 change places with partners, giving right hands.
- 13 - 14 All six join nearer hands in threes again, advance slightly with the pas-de-basque; and
- 15 - 16 turn their partners half-way round with both hands. (The second couple are now on the 'wrong' sides; the others in their original places).

- 17 - 24 All six dance a grand chain. To start, the first couple dance across, the second couple down, and the third couple up. (The men should meet women and the women men as they dance the chain).

- 25 - 28 The first and second couples dance half-right-and-left.
- 29 - 32 The first couple turn to their own sides with right hands.
