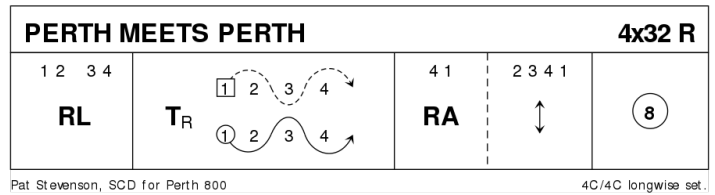

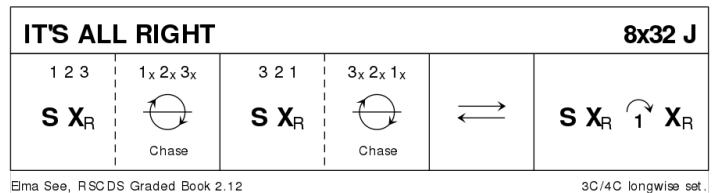
- 1-8 | 1s+2s also 3s+4s dance R&L
- 9-16 | 1s turn RH & cast 1 place, 1s weave down to 4th place as others step up as they are passed
- 17-20 | 4s+1s dance RH across, 2s+3s+4s+1s Adv+Ret
- 25-32 | All circle 8H round & back

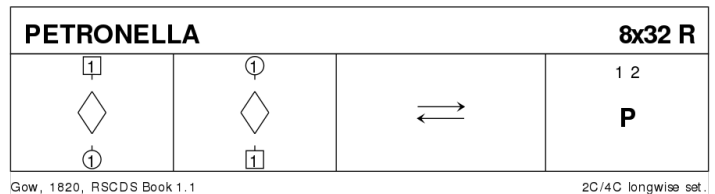
- 1- | All set and cross RH ; chase ½ clw (3,2,1)
- 9- | Repeat (1,2,3)
- 17- | 1c down the middle and up
- 25- | 1c set | cross RH ; cast off (2c up) | cross RH (2,1,3)

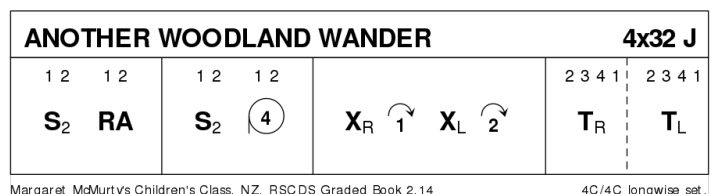
- 1- | 1c Petronella Turn | set ; repeat (1x,2)
- 9- | Repeat (1,2)
- 17- | 1c lead down the middle and up
- 25- | 1c+2c Poussette (2,1)

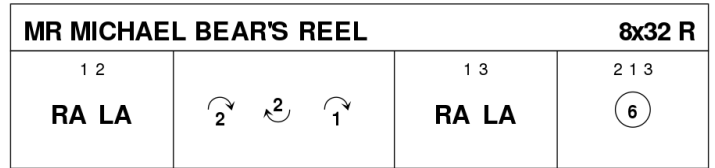
- 1-8 | 1+2C set twice ; 1+2C RH across
- 9-16 | 1+2C set twice ; 1+2C Circle4 L
- 7-24 | 1C cross R, cast off (2C up) ; 1C cross L, cast off two pl (3+4C up)
- 5-32 | All turn R ; all turn L



5 MR MICHAEL BEAR'S REEL R32 · 3/4L

- 1- 1c+2c RHA ; LHA
- 9- 1c cast off 2, meet, dance to top, cast (2c up) (2,1,3)
- 17- 1c+3c RHA ; LHA
- 25- All circle6 and back (2,1,3)



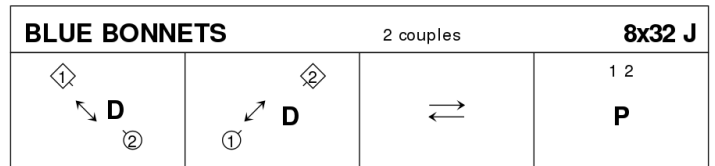

- 9- 1M+2W repeat
- 17- 1c lead down the middle and up
- 25- 1c+2c Poussette



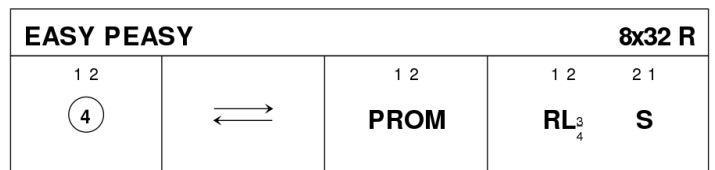

- 1- Circle4 and back
- 9- 1c lead down the middle and up
- 17- 1c+2c Promenade
- 25- 3/4 R&L {6} | 2c+1c set



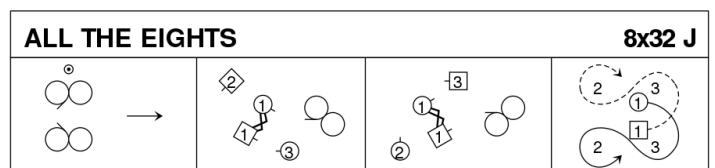

8 ALL THE EIGHTS J32 · 3/4L

- 1-6 Reel of three on the sides, 1s crossing
- 7-8 1s dance down to face 3m, promenade hold, 2c dance to 1st place
- 9-16 1s dance R Sh reel of three with 2nd corners
- 17-24 1s dance L Sh reel of three with 1st corners
- 24-32 1s cross down between 3s, cast up to 2nd place, dance up between 2s, cast to 2nd place own sides



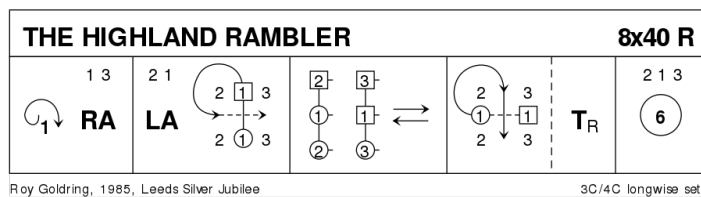

9 THE HIGHLAND RAMBLER R40 · 3/4L

Roy Goldring: Silver Jubilee 25 - Leeds Branch · Crib: Eric Ferguson's SCD Cribs · Diagram: Keith Rose's Diagrams

- 1- 1c long cast to 2pl (2c up on [3-4] ; 1c+3c RHA (2,1,3)
- 9- 2c+1c LHA, 1W faces out ; 1W followed by 1M cast up round 2W and down the middle of set, 1W between 3c and 1M between 2c, all facing down
- 17- In lines of 3 down the middle (all swivel R) and up
- 25- 1M followed by 1W dance up, cast round 2W and into 2pl ; 1c turn RH
- 33- Circle6 and back

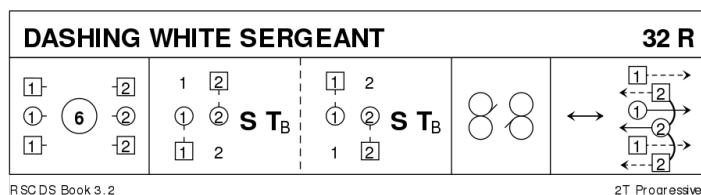


10 THE DASHING WHITE SERGEANT R32 · 3+3RR

RSCDS III 2 · Crib: Eric Ferguson's SCD Cribs · Diagram: Keith Rose's Diagrams

Trio face trio RR.

- 1- Circle6 and back
- 9- Each centre person sets to RH P and turns him/her BH ; repeat with LH P
- 17- Reel3 across, Lsh to RH P
- 25- In lines of 3 across A&R ; advance Rsh through the opposite line of 3 to meet the next line of 3.
